No. 1 ,No. 2, No. 3

Make sure to change them to the same number like in the example below

Example $2\frac{1}{3} + 1\frac{1}{4}$

$$\frac{1}{3} = \frac{4}{12}$$

$$\frac{1}{4} = \frac{3}{12}$$

$$2\frac{4}{12} + 1\frac{3}{12} = 3\frac{7}{12}$$

Page 4 No. 1 and 2 Hint: divide by the top and multiply x by the top

CHOCOLATE BUNS

Ingredients: 175 grams of white self raising flour

125 g of butter or margarine(soft, not straight out of the fridge)

125 g caster sugar

1 dessert spoon of coco powder

2 eggs

3 dessert spoons of milk

Turn on the oven to 200 degrees so that it's heated when the buns are ready to go in

Get a bun tray and have paper buns cases put in it.

Put the butter and sugar into a big mixing bowl (so that you have plenty room for mixing without the mixture falling out)

Mix up well until there are no lumps and it is smooth. Add the eggs to the bowl and mix well again. Then sieve in the flour and coco powder and mix away. Finally, add the milk , but you may not need it , unless the mixture is too dry. Spoon the mixture into the bun cases and put into the oven immediately (they don't taste as good , if the mixture is sitting around for a while)

Bake in the oven for about 20 minutes- you will know when they are done by the look of them.

And again, get an ADULT to take them out of the oven. Allow them to cool . Then gobble them up and enjoy. Ye deserve it !!!

Maths: Puzzle answers to last week

1. *More than two animals: I have more than two animals at home. All of them are dogs, except for two. All of them are cats, except for two. All of them are hamsters, except for two. What kinds of animals and how many of each animal do I have?*

Solution: I have three animals: one dog, one cat, and one hamster.

2. *A Farmer and his ducks: A farmer was asked how many ducks he had. "Well," he said, "they ran down the path just now and I saw one duck in front of two ducks, a duck behind two ducks, and a duck between two ducks." How many ducks were there?*


Solution: There are three ducks, one in front of another.

3. *Milkman's Containers: A milkman has an 8-liter container full of milk, and also two empty containers that measure 5 liters and 3 liters. He needs to deliver 4 liters of milk to a customer. The milkman has no other spare containers and no way to mark any containers. He does not want to pour milk away. How will he measure the 4 liters of milk?*

Fill the 5-liter container.

- 1. Pour out from the 5-liter container to the 3-liter one until it's full. The 5-liter container now has 2 liters left.*
- 2. Pour all the milk from the 3-liter container back to the 8-liter container.*
- 3. Pour the 2 liters from the 5-liter container to the 3-liter container. It has therefore just one liter of space left!*
- 4. Fill the 5-liter container.*
- 5. Pour out from the 5-liter container enough milk to fill the 3-liter container (which already has 2 liters). You will have 4 liters left in the 5-liter container.*
