Abair Liom: This is the book and online resources we use at school. There are lots of great interactive games, posters, songs etc. online. The children love it! To login following these instructions:

- 5. Click 'Register'. You will then be sent an email (check your 'Promotions' folder if using Gmail) to activate your account.
 - Launch the poster Turas Scoile go dtí an bhFeirm (School Tour to the Farm). (Page 11 of Abair Liom B Resources)
 - Click on the button called 'Scéal' (Story).
 - Play the story for your child. The audio and translation are given below.

Tá Seán agus Síofra ag an bhfeirm. (Seán and Síofra are at the farm.)

Tá bó, capall, caora, muc agus sicíní ar an bhfeirm. (There is a cow, horse, sheep, pig and chickens on the farm.)

Tá Síofra ag féachaint ar na hainmhithe. (Síofra is looking at the animals.)

Thug Seán bia don capall. (Seán gave food to the horse.)

- Play the story once a day so that your child becomes familiar with the language. Help them to understand the story.
- Launch the poster Turas Scoile go dtí an bhFeirm (School Tour to the Farm).
- Click the button called 'Fóclóir 1' (Vocabulary 1)
- Play the vocabulary activity with your child and make sure they understand the meaning of the words:

Fóclóir 1: an fheirm (the farm), bó (cow), capall (horse), muc (pig), caora (sheep), sicín (chicken), éan (bird)

• Repeat these steps with 'Fóclóir 2' (Vocabulary 2)

<u>Fóclóir 2</u>: geata (gate), bus (bus), páistí (children), ainmhithe (animals), ag féachaint (looking), ag ithe (eating)

Maths:

- Oral Maths: Build a tower of 10 blocks/ 10 pasta shells. Tell
 them to take an amount away. They must tell you how many are
 left. Repeat this activity.
- Maths at home book pg. 28.
- Maths at school book pg. 105, 106, 107.
- Maths copy: Write the days of the week 3 times. Ask questions like "What day was yesterday?", "If today was Friday, what day is it tomorrow?" etc.
- Practical work: Roll 2 dice. Which number is greater? By how much?
